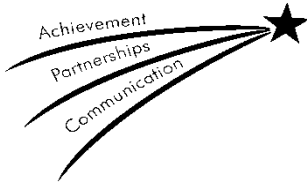

Annual Notification

Dear Parents and Guardians of Pleasanton Unified School District Students:

On October 22, 1986, the President signed into law the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) which requires that the District annually notify employees, building occupants or their legal guardians and outside vendors regarding AHERA related activities. This includes building inspections, re-inspections, response actions and post-response action activities, including periodic re-inspections and surveillance activities that are planned or are in progress.

The original Inspection Report and Management Plan have been available for review at the District Office since the spring of 1989. As required by AHERA, the Three Year Re-inspections have been completed since 1989, the most recent during summer, 2011, and are available. All reports have been included in the Management Plan located at school sites and the District Office. Information regarding any specific abatement activities is included in the Re-Inspection Report.
