RULES

- Students will be required to check in for buses 30 minutes after the graduation ceremony is completed. **You must check in at school and take the bus to attend Grad Night. Students who do not follow this procedure will not be allowed to attend. For safety, liability and administration reasons, individual student vehicle transportation will not be an option.**
- All graduates attending Grad Night must have this Rules form and the Liability Waiver signed and on file with the Grad Night Committee. Graduates are expected to be respectful and conduct themselves in accordance with the Liability Waiver and these Rules. Eligibility to purchase admission and attend Grad Night is contingent upon purchaser being a registered senior student of FHS and deemed eligible to participate in school events as designated by district behavioral policy. Any ticket previously purchased or granted to student who is subsequently suspended, expelled or restricted from school sponsored events will be refunded and the student will not be allowed to attend the event.
- **For driving safety at the late return hour** and parking congestion early in the evening, **parents are strongly encouraged to drive or car pool their students to graduation and pick them up at FHS where buses will return after the event.**
- Other than IDs (required for check in), and cell phones, **students are not allowed to bring personal items (this includes but is not exclusive to purses/backpacks/jackets (unless worn)/ipods/cameras.** Students will have the **option** to turn over phones and ID's at check in to be held in a secure area for the duration of the event. Phones will be available at the venue should a student need to contact a parent. The Grad Night Committee is NOT responsible for any lost, stolen, or forgotten items.
- No food or beverages can be brought to Grad Night by any graduate.
- Anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be detained and parents will be called to pick up his/her graduate. If no parent can be reached, the matter will be turned over to the Pleasanton Police Department. A police officer and parent security volunteers will be at Grad Night throughout the evening. **THIS POLICY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
- If a graduate has paid admission, but fails to check in, the graduate's parents will be notified and informed.
- No refunds will be given unless there is a medical reason with a doctors note, or student is no longer registered at FHS.
- **No graduate of any age will be allowed to leave before the end of the event** unless the Grad Night Committee initiates a call to his/her parents to authorize early departure and they agree to physically come sign out the student at the venue site in Livermore. The person signing out/picking up the graduate must be listed below on this Rules form.
- Once a graduate leaves, he/she will not be allowed back into the event.

LIABILITY WAIVER

1. WAIVER, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK:

This Waiver, Release and Assumption of Risk covers Foothill High School and any and all activities related to Grad Night 2012, including (i) the use of any and all Foothill High School facilities and (ii) participation in any and all Grad Night activities. I represent and covenant that: (i) my child's participation in this activity is voluntary, (ii) my child is physically fit to participate in Grad Night 2012 and (iii) he/she will not be under the influence of or use any drugs, tobacco or alcohol prior to or during Grad Night 2012. I understand that Grad Night 2012 involves risk and that serious injury could occur while my child is participating in Grad Night activities. Knowing these risks, I want my child to participate in Grad Night 2012. On behalf of my child, my spouse or partner and myself, I, the undersigned parent/legal guardian of my child, hereby (i) assume the full risk of my child's participation in Grad Night 2012 and (ii) waive, release and discharge Foothill High School, the Pleasanton Unified School District, the City of Pleasanton, the Grad Night 2012 Parent Committee of Foothill High School (Class of 2012), any and all vendors or service providers providing goods and services at Grad Night 2012 and any and all other entities, officials, agents, sponsors and promoters of Grad Night 2012 (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all liability or responsibility for personal injury or property damage incurred or suffered by my child or any member of my family in the course of participating in Grad Night 2012, including transportation to or from Grad Night 2012. Further, I will defend, indemnify and hold the Indemnified Parties harmless from and against any claims, liabilities or other expenses arising out of any injury, damage or loss incurred or suffered by any third party due to the acts or omissions of my child or any member of our family. I acknowledge and agree that I have read the foregoing and fully understand that I am waiving important legal rights on behalf of myself, my family and my child.

2. AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT:

I, the undersigned parent/legal guardian of my child, hereby give consent to any emergency treatment deemed advisable and to be rendered by any licensed physician on the staff of any accredited hospital, whether rendered at the physician's office or at the hospital. It is understood that this authorization is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment or hospital care being required but is given to authorize any and all such diagnosis, treatment or hospital care which the aforementioned physician, in the exercise of his or her best judgment, may deem advisable. I further acknowledge and agree that the cost of any such treatment, aid or care will be my sole responsibility and I will indemnify and hold the Indemnified Parties (as defined above) harmless from and against any claims, liabilities or other expenses arising in connection with the seeking, obtaining and provision of such treatment, aid or care. This authorization is given pursuant to the California Medical Practice Act, Sections 2395, *et seq.* of the Business and Professions Code of California, and other applicable California statutes and regulations.

EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, COMPLETE WAIVER AND AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to compete, officiate, work for, use the property, its facilities and/or services (the "FACILITIES"), and/or participate in any way in the OPERATION OF A GO-KART AT UMIGO RACING, INC. ALSO DOING BUSINESS AS UMIGO INDOOR KART RACING, or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (defined any area requiring special authorization, credentials, or permission to enter any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself or herself, his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1) Acknowledges, agrees, and represents that he/she have and will immediately upon entering any such RESTRICTED AREAS, and will continuously thereafter, inspect the RESTRICTED AREA which he/she enters, and he/she further agrees and warrants that, if at any time, he/she is in or about the RESTRICTED AREAS and he/she feels anything to be unsafe, he/she will immediately advise the official of such and if necessary will leave the RESTRICTED AREAS and/or refuse to participate further in the RENTAL AND OPERATION OF A GO-KART.

2) HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES, AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE: UMIGO RACING, INC., the track operators, the track owners, the corporate officers of UMIGO RACING, INC., the share owners of UMIGO RACING, INC., the employees of UMIGO RACING, INC., the owners and lessees of FACILITIES and premises used to conduct the OPERATION OF A GO-KART, the officials, the vehicle owners, the drivers, the pit crews, the rescue personnel, any persons in any RESTRICTED AREA, the promoters, the participants, the racing associations, the sanctioning organizations, the sponsors, the advertisers, the manufacturers of the equipment utilized in the FACILITIES and in the OPERATION OF A GO-KART, the premises inspectors, the event inspectors, the surveyors, the underwriters, the consultants, and others who give recommendations, directions, or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises, facilities or the OPERATION OF A GO-KART and each of them, their directors, officers, agents and employees, or any subdivisions thereof, all for the purposes herein referred to as "Releasees," FROM ALL LIABILITY TO THE UNDERSIGNED, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFOR ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO OPERATION OF A GO-KART OR USE OF THE FACILITIES, WHETHER CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.

3) HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees and each of them FROM ANY LOSS, LIABILITY, DAMAGE, OR COST they may incur directly or indirectly arising from any action or other proceeding brought by or prosecuted for my benefit contrary to the release extended to all claims of every kind and nature what-so-ever whether known or unknown and expressly waive any benefits I may have under Sect. 1542 of California Civil Code relating to the release of unknown claims.

4) HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE arising out of or related to the RENTAL AND OPERATION OF A GO-KART, whether caused by the NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES or otherwise.

5) HEREBY acknowledges that the ACTIVITY OF RENTING AND OPERATING A GO-KART IS VERY DANGEROUS and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or personal property damage. THE UNDERSIGNED, also expressly acknowledges that INJURIES RECEIVED MAY BE COMPOUNDED OR INCREASED BY THE NEGLIGENCE RESCUE OPERATIONS OR PROCEDURES OF THE RELEASEES. THE UNDERSIGNED also expressly acknowledges that INJURIES RECEIVED MAY BE COMPOUNDED OR INCREASED BY THE WEARING OF EYEGLASSES BY THE UNDERSIGNED.

6) HEREBY agrees that this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the Releasees, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE RESCUE OPERATIONS and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the Province or State in which the OPERATION OF A GO-KART is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in the full legal force and effect.

7) Acknowledges and agrees to **pay for any and all damages to the facilities and/or equipment** caused by the UNDERSIGNED, negligently, willfully, accidentally or otherwise; and

8) HEREBY AGREES that participating in events or the utilization of FACILITIES of UMIGO RACING, INC., I acknowledge that I fully understand the significant inherent dangers of driving and/or racing the vehicles offered to the UNDERSIGNED and I further acknowledge that I will read and comply with the safety rules for driving such vehicles (and if I do not understand any point or part of the safety rules, I will advise an official of UMIGO RACING, INC and request further assistance so that I may fully understand them before using the FACILITIES).

I hereby represent and warrant to Umigo Racing, Inc. that each of the following are true:

- 1) I have read this release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk and indemnity agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and have signed it freely and voluntarily without any inducement, assurance or guarantee being made to me and intend my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law.
- 2) **I am at least 58 inches tall. I am not pregnant. I have not consumed alcohol or drugs which may affect my ability to rent and operate a go-kart in a safe manner.**
- 3) I do not suffer from ANY health conditions which may be aggravated by driving a go-kart including, but not limited to, heart conditions, high blood pressure, carbon monoxide allergies, back, neck, or other skeletal or muscular or joint problems.
- 4) I will wear a helmet and eye protection while operating a go-kart and while I am in or around the race track area.
- 5) I will attend the required driver's briefing meeting; obey all rules, regulations and instructions from Umigo Racing, Inc. personnel.

- 6) I will drive slowly until familiar with the track and equipment. **I will not willfully crash my go kart or bump the other go-karts.**
- 7) I understand that Umigo Racing, Inc. personnel have the right to cease the operation of the go-karts at any time and for any reason. Umigo Racing Inc. personnel can remove me from the FACILITIES at any time for any reason with no right of refund.
